This 12-week hybrid certificate program is designed to provide students with theoretical instruction and practical skills necessary to obtain entry-level positions in a medical office. The Medical Clinical Assistant curriculum will include administrative and clinical patient care theory.

ABOUT THE COURSE

- Theory: 12 hours a week for 9 weeks for a total 108 hrs.
- Lab: 6 hours a week for 9 weeks for a total of 54 hours.
- Clinical: 40 hours a week for 3 weeks for a total of 120 hours.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

MassHire grants are for income-eligible or unemployed individuals who are seeking employment. Grants will only be awarded to those who agree to find training related employment upon course completion and obtainment of industry certification. MassHire also provides job placement assistance to program participants.
