April 20 <u>Apprentice & On-the-Job</u> <u>Training</u>

Apprenticeships are work-based training programs that give you hands-on experience in a structured environment. On-the-Job Training (OJT) Program assists employers with the cost of hiring & training a new employee. It is funded through the Workforce Investment and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and administered through the MassHire Career Centers.

June 8 <u>DIA's Workplace</u> Safety Training Grant

The prevention of occupational injury and illness is in everyone's best interest. The goal of this highly successful program is to promote safe and healthy conditions in the workplace through training, education, and other preventative programs.

May 4 and May 11 Department of Revenue (DOR)

Learn about the mandatory process of withholding income for child support as an employer (wages garnished). Over 70% of small companies are dealing with this and I have seen her present. It was very popular with employers. If you're an employer and you receive an income withholding order, you must withhold a specific amount of income from that employee's paycheck for child support.

June 15 <u>WOTC</u>

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a federal tax credit available to employers who invest in American job seekers who have consistently faced barriers to employment. Employers may meet their business needs and claim a tax credit if they hire an individual who is in a WOTC targeted group.
