ABOUT THE COURSE

Hybrid program with training available in New Bedford or Fall River. Program length and format varies by location. The course is followed by a mandatory full-time, 3-week, 100-hour clinical practicum at an affiliate location. Programs start September 2, 2025. This program is no-cost to eligible applicants.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

MassHire grants are for income-eligible or unemployed individuals who are seeking employment. Grants will only be awarded to those who agree to find training-related employment upon course completion and obtainment of industry certification. MassHire also provides job placement assistance to program participants.

This project is funded by the Healthcare/Behavioral Health Hub Continuation Grant (Workforce Competitiveness Trust Fund FY'21 Appropriation) and funds appropriated through the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021.
