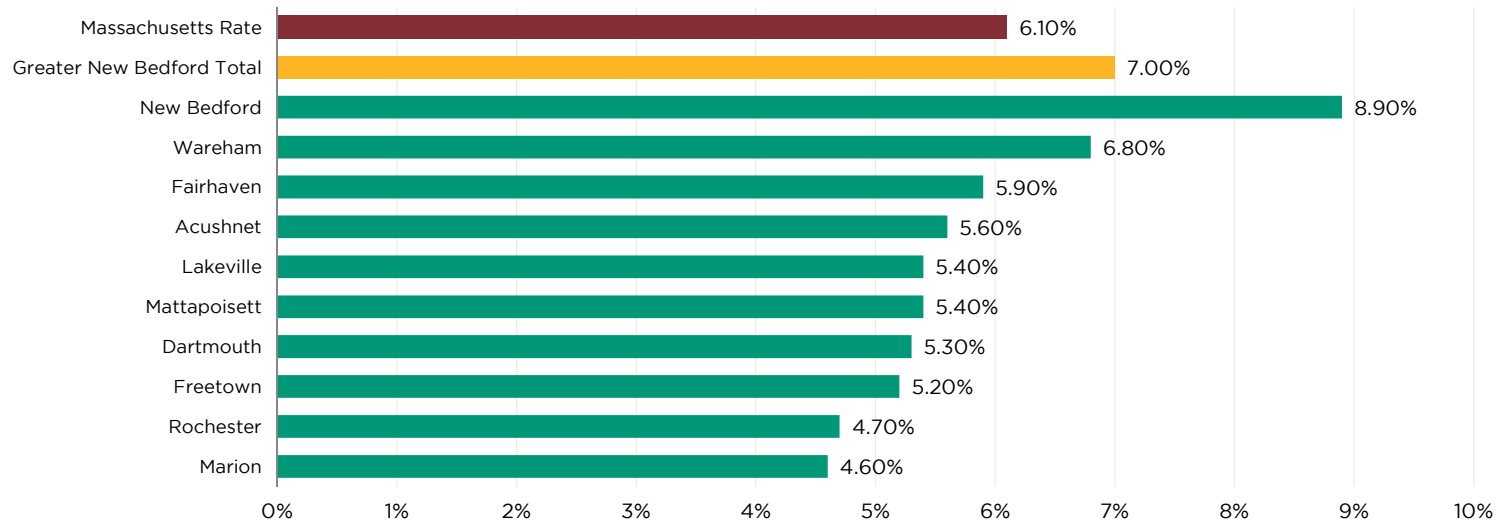

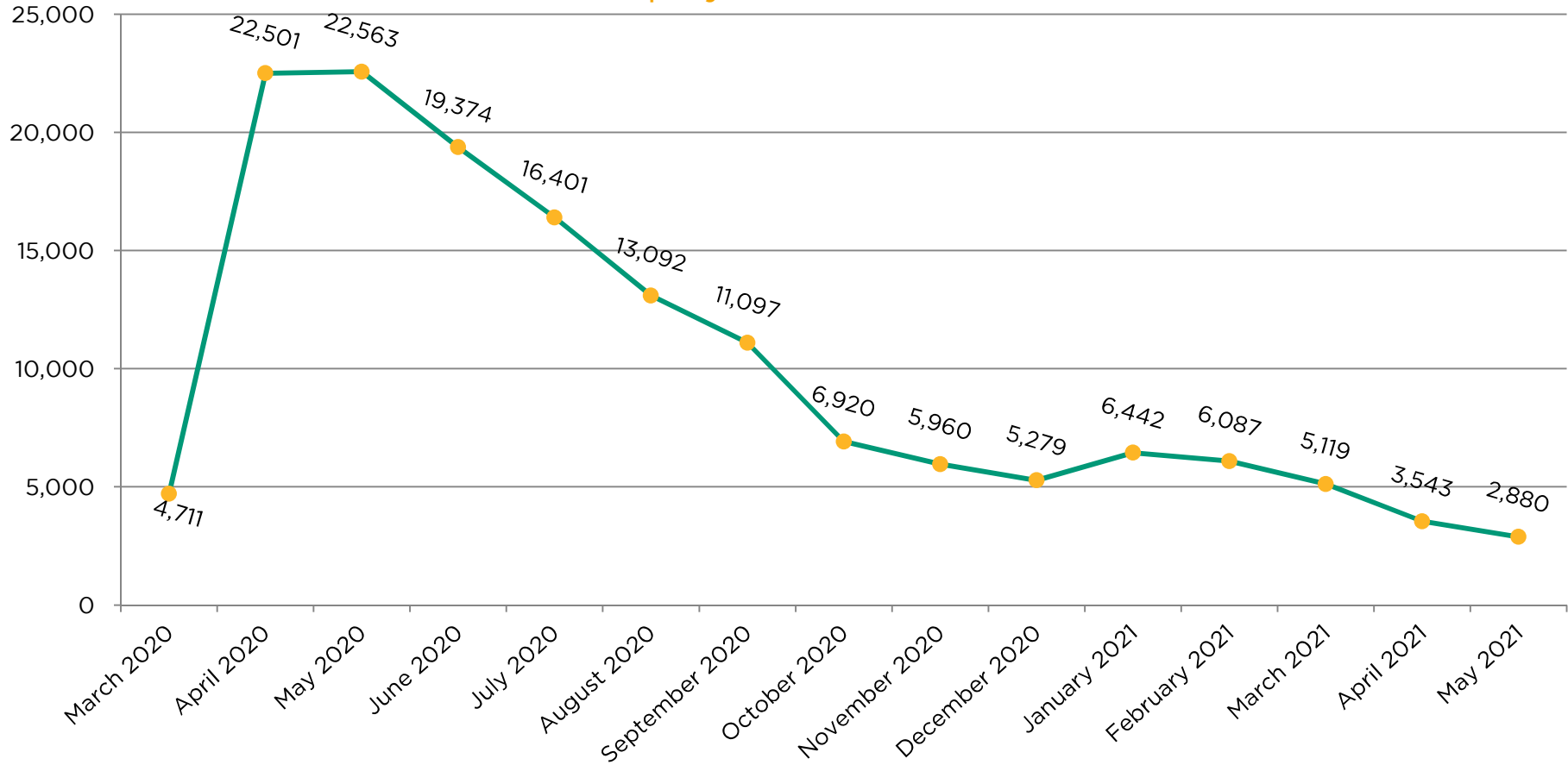
May 2021 Unemployment Rates By City and Town

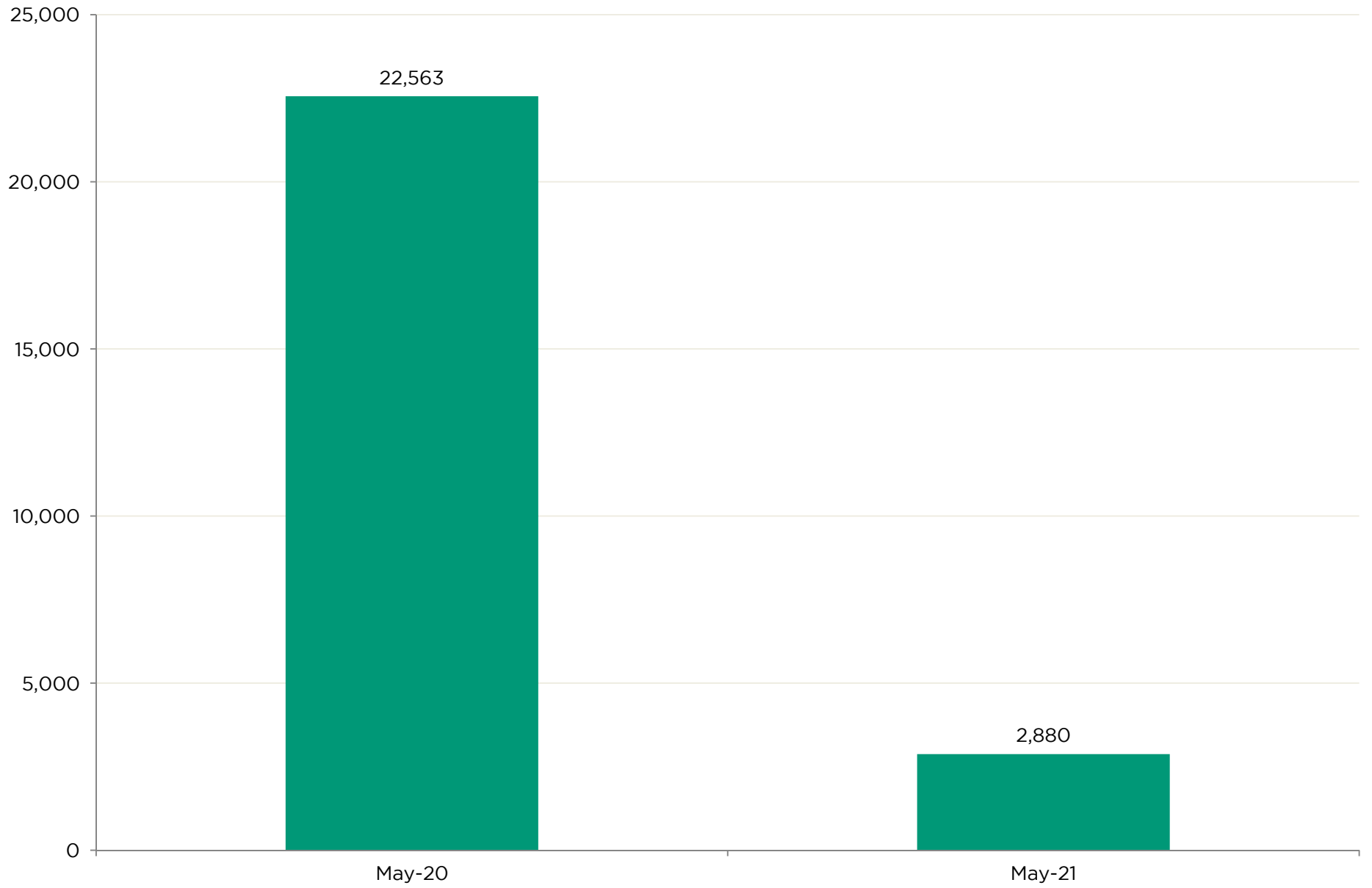
Total Unemployment Insurance Claimants

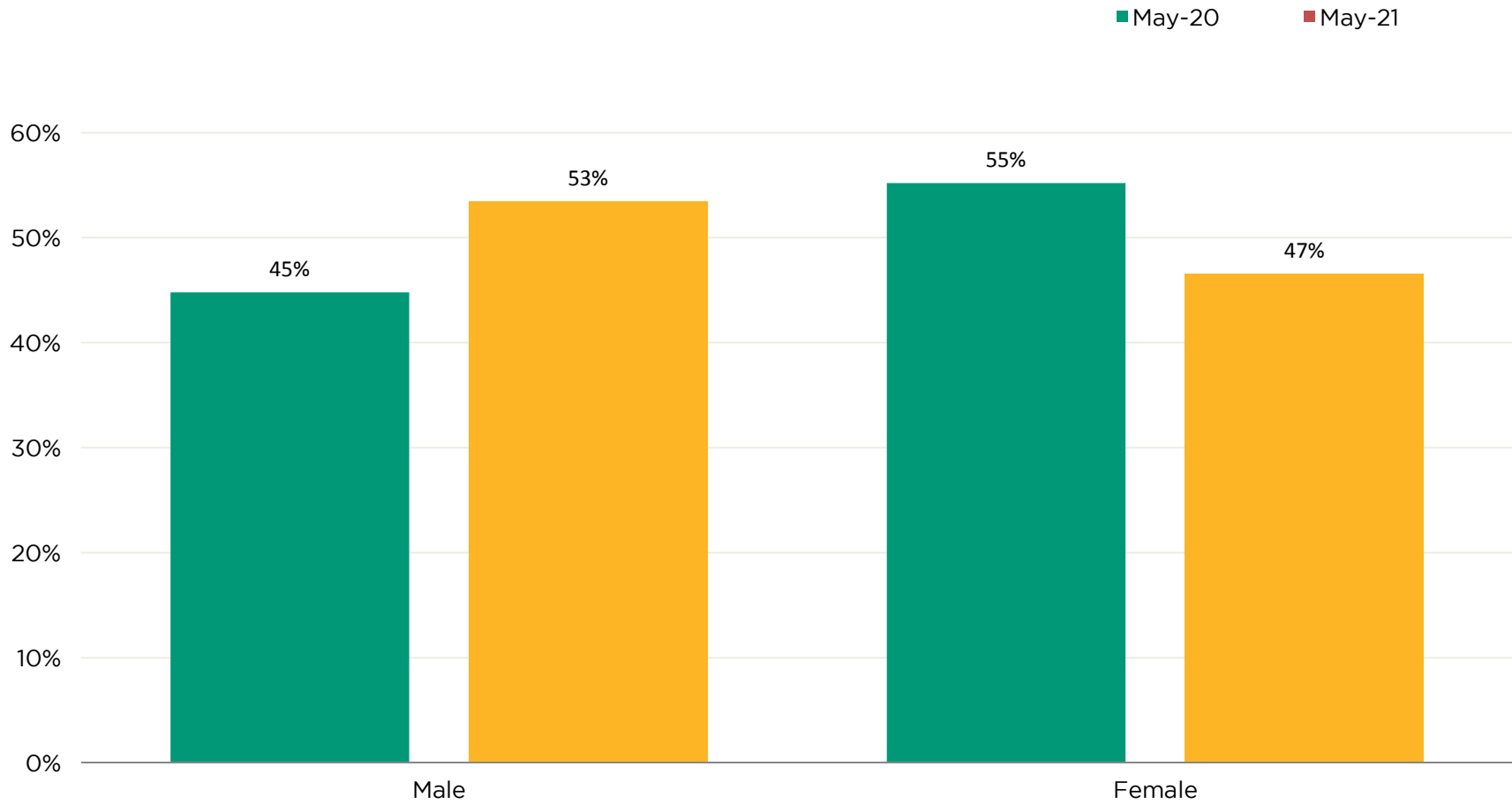

GNB WDA Unemployment Claimants 2020-2021 Comparison

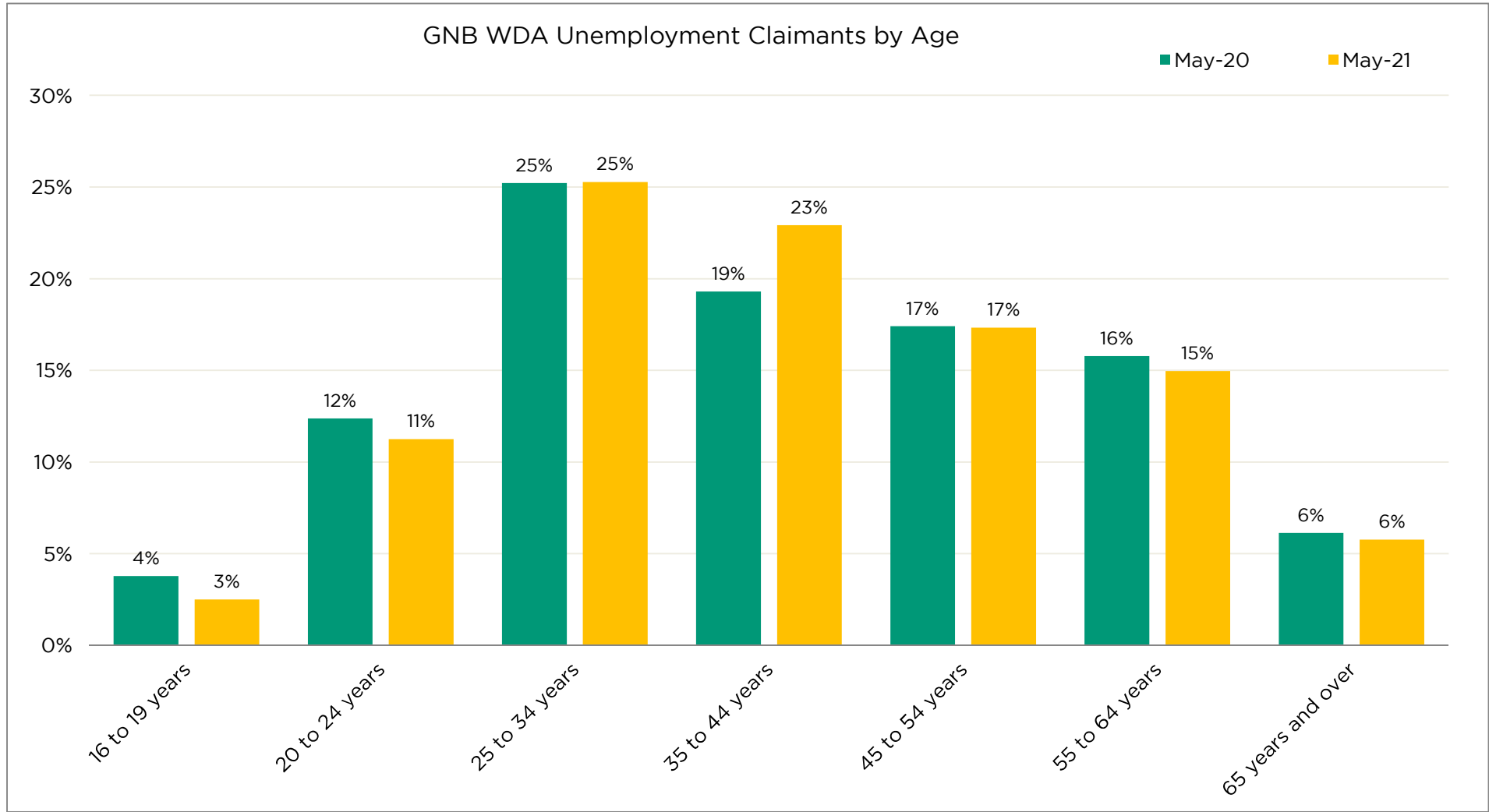

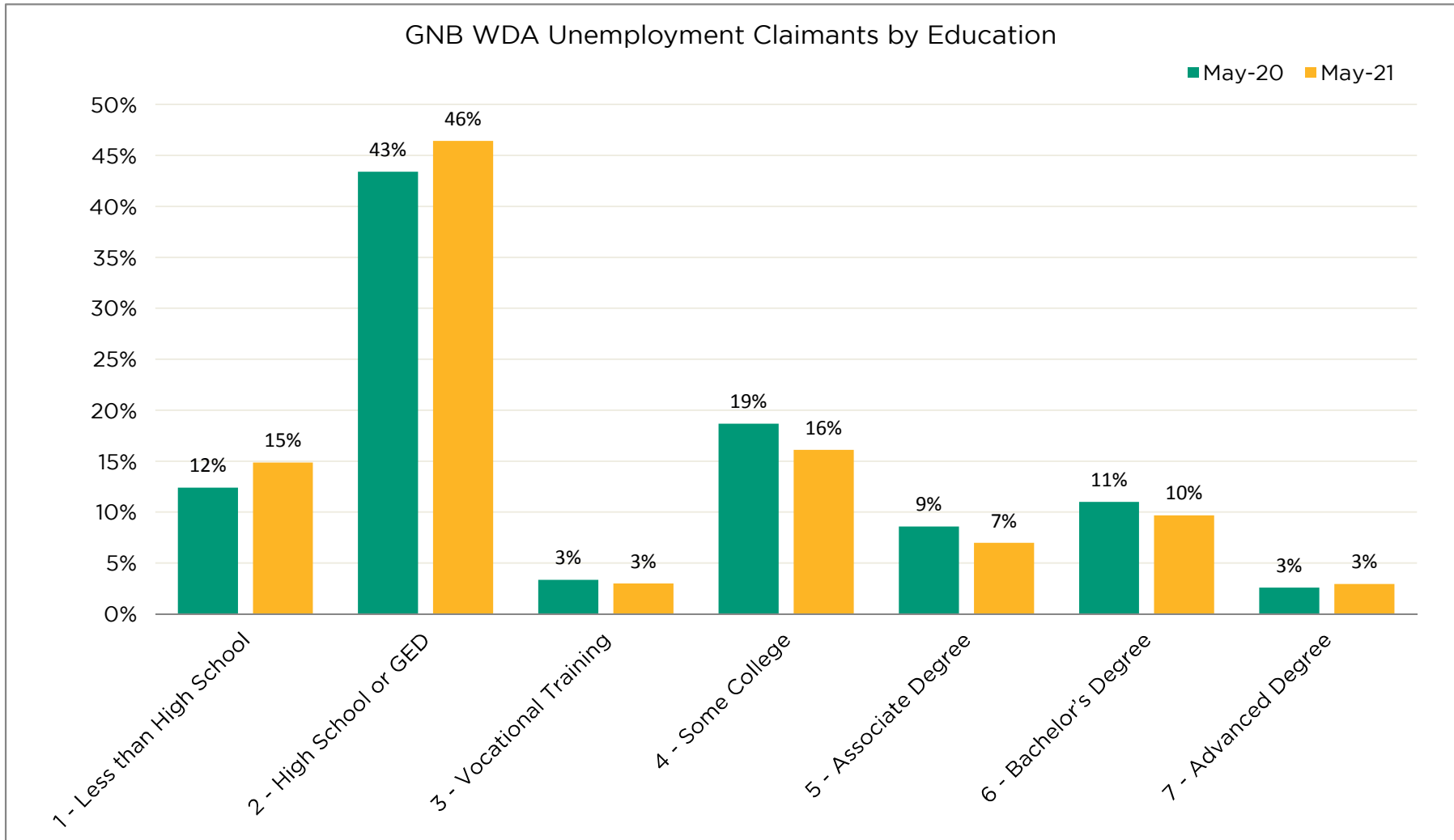
GNB WDA Unemployment Claimants by Gender 2020- 2021 Comparison

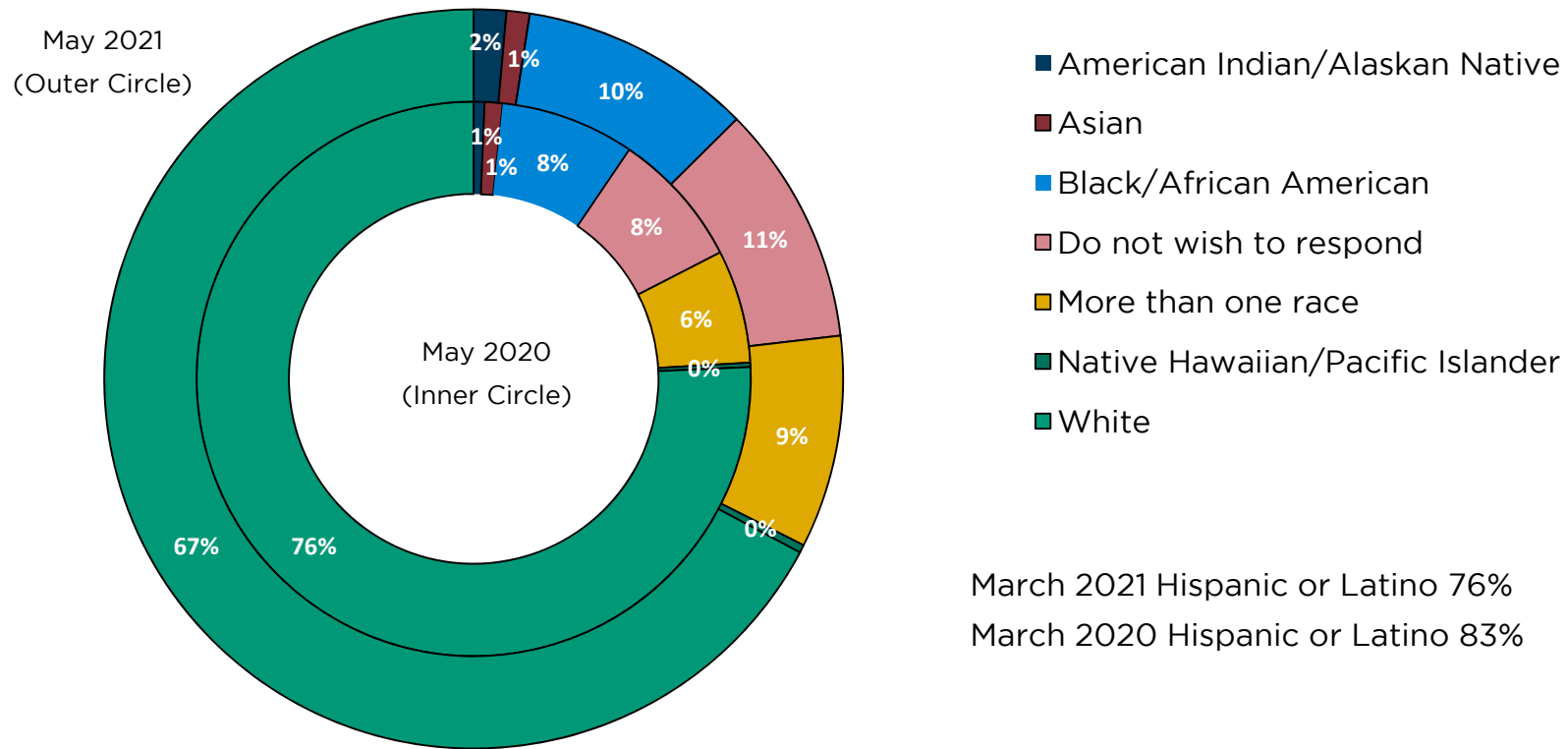

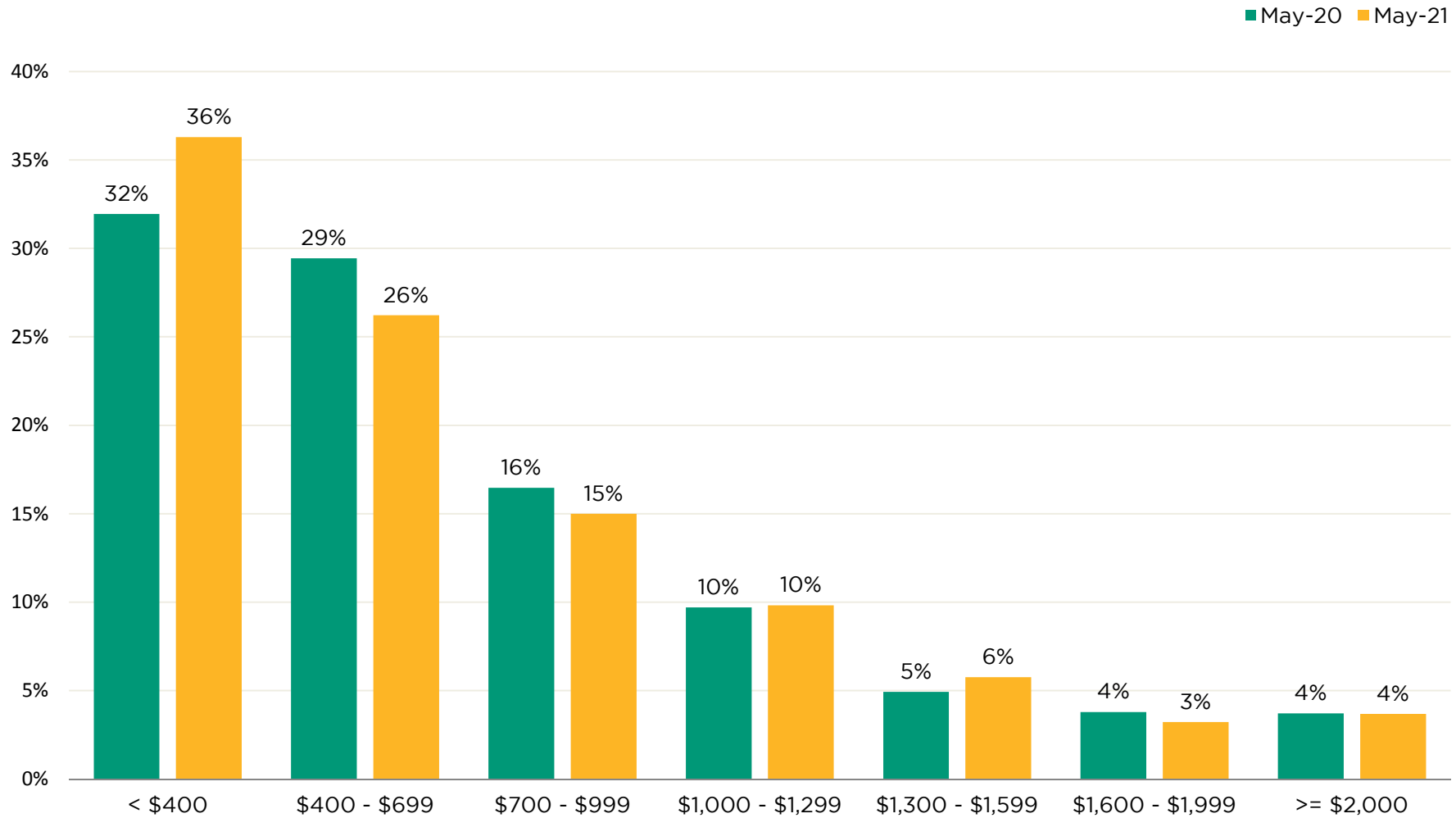

GNB WDA Unemployment Claimants by Ethnicity



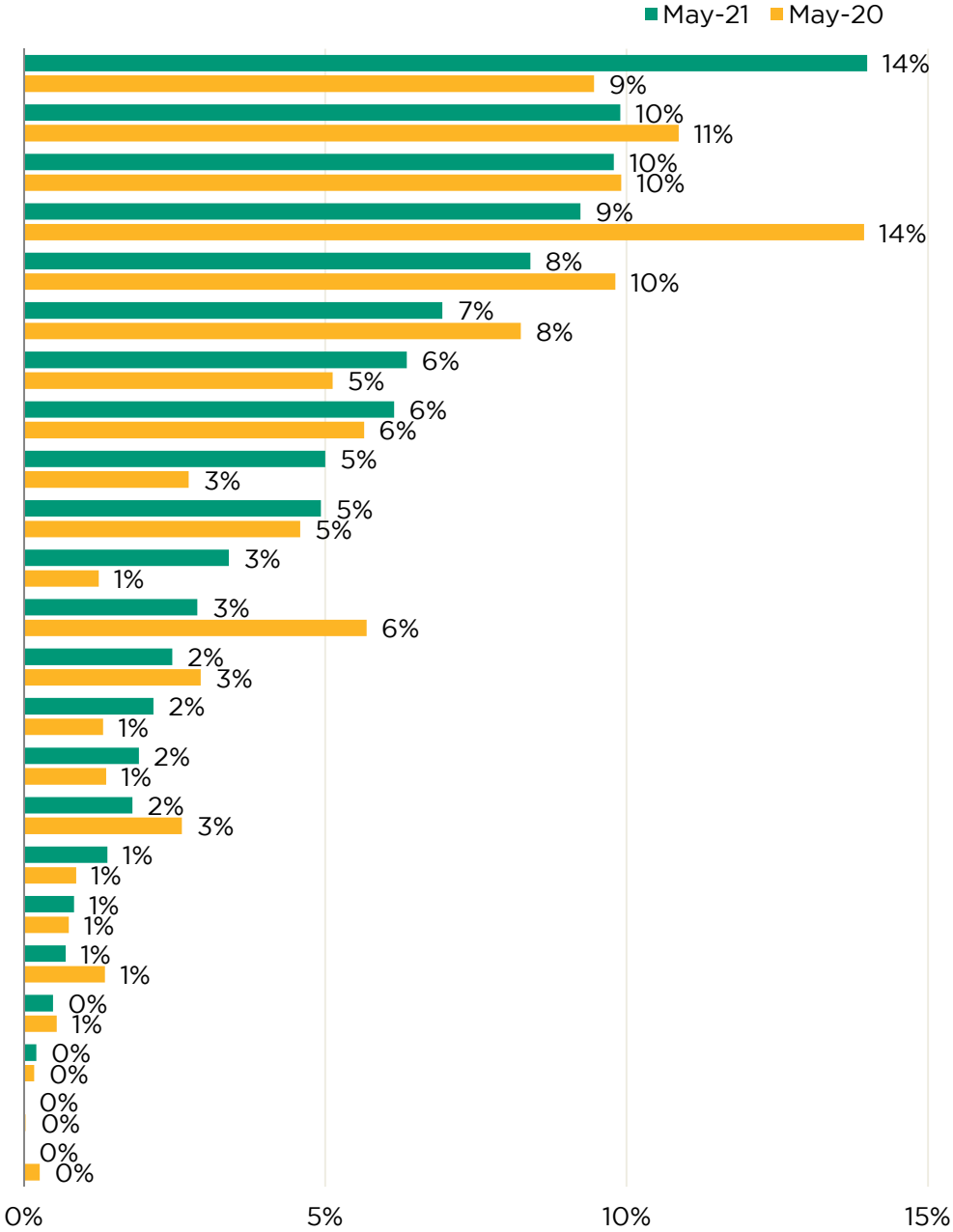
