## ABOUT THE COURSE

This course trains students for phlebotomy jobs in various healthcare settings, including doctors' offices, clinics, hospitals, and insurance companies. This course will teach you the information and skills needed to become a certified phlebotomist. This program is no-cost to eligible applicants.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

MassHire grants are for income-eligible or unemployed individuals who are seeking employment. Grants will only be awarded to those who agree to find training related employment upon course completion and obtainment of industry certification. MassHire also provides job placement assistance to program participants.
