Eligible participants must agree to complete the course, obtain certification, and find a job in the field. MassHire will assist participants in securing employment.

This is an in-depth **Emergency Medical Technician** course in basic life support. Students learn about acute illnesses, medical emergencies, traumatic emergencies, childbirth, rescue extrication, ambulance operations, splinting techniques, communication and documentation, medical-legal implications, AED/CPR, basic medications and their effects.

The course meets or exceeds current National EMS Guidelines and has Massachusetts OEMS approval. Students will earn 6 college credits upon program completion.
